Introduction

- Assessment is a process in which examples of person's attitude are taken at particular time and they are evaluated.
- 'Technology-enhanced assessment' refers to the wide range of ways in which technology can be used to support assessment and feedback. It includes on-screen assessment, often called e-assessment.

Objective

- Enable management of course schedule
- Enable update of class activities, homework and project results
- Enable update of midterm and final exam results
- Enable evaluation of activities and assessment of knowledge
- Provide electronic access to academic results

Benefits

- immediate feedback to students,
- immediate feedback to staff,
- evaluation of a course's strengths and weaknesses,
- can be linked to other computer-based or online materials.
- remote access and choice of time and place of assessment
- Time saving?

Requirements

- Manage large number of candidate knowledge assessment details.
- maintain and exchange candidate's data with other systems or modules in an effective way
- View all the details of the students assessment history.
- Create the statistical reports.

Requirements

- Enable the candidates to take proactive role in the learning process by assessing their knowledge
- Provide the candidates with feedback which can be valuable for the learning process itself
