- based on industry standards



Trend-setting approach




- Principle: "Assembling" software rather than "programming" - an application consists of various "building blocks"
- Effective building blocks (e.g. form input fields, powerful search fields, table-based and graphical data representation) permit very rapid development
- Expandable "tool box" (via Java/XML and related technologies)
- Supports creating rapid prototypes to quickly visualize the specification
